## PLEASE FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS BELOW:

1. Come to the front window.
2. To check in, give the receptionist the phone number of the cell phone you have in your possession at the time of check-in.
3. The staff will ask if you have a fever, cough, or shortness of breath:
  - If **YES**: we will give you a mask to put on.  
**You will need to keep the mask on for the entire visit.**
  - If **NO**: proceed to 4.
4. Go to your **car** to wait.  
Our staff will **CALL YOU** to tell you when to come in for your appointment.  
(We will be calling the number you gave us in step 1)
5. When done with your appointment, you will be walked out of the clinic and will **NOT** need to stop by the front desk. **Go straight to your car & we will call you shortly to make the follow-up appointment.**

**Please note that this swab is not able to determine if you have the coronavirus.** Results will take 24 hours, and we will call you with your results.

### POSSIBLE RESULTS FROM THE SWAB:

- No infection: no need for further action.
- Bacterial Infection: we will prescribe the proper antibiotics to you.
- Viral Infection: will either be determined or unknown  
For **UNKNOWN viral infections**: we recommend that you self-quarantine until you feel 100%. Please discuss any further actions with your physician.  
If your symptoms **WORSEN**, please go to the hospital to get checked.
